



Shareholder Water Usage January - March 2024





Cross Connection Backflow Testing Due May 1st

Do you have any water source that is continually hooked up to supply water outside of normal plumbing? Things such as an irrigation system or water treatment system require you to have a backflow device installed for those systems and an annual inspection by a Cross Connection Control Specialist who will provide you with a report to submit to CCWP. This helps prevent cross contamination and keeps our water safe and healthy for everyone. 
Irrigation Systems—What you Need to Know:

We had several shareholders who were surprised by their July through September 2023 water usage and subsequent bill. Watering lawns and gardens, filling pools, and other outdoor uses tend to utilize large quantities of water and due to our tiered water billing structure (recommended by state government to encourage conservation), greatly increases your water bill.

Please see the chart below for a visual representation of this exponential cost of water. The blue line represents the water usage charges on your quarterly billing based on your gallon water usage in a single quarter.

To avoid sticker shock with each summer quarter billing, you can track your usage using your water meter. A simple act of subtracting readings will give you your usage in cubic feet (NOTE: all our meters are in cubic feet but we charge per gallon; 1 cf³ = 7.48 gal.). Contact the office for help calculating the dollar amount of that usage and for any other information you may need.
